

Lost Pet Checklist

1. We strongly recommend that you come to the animal shelter and file a lost pet report in person. If that is not possible, call 697-4723 and file your report. Include any information that would help identify your dog such as a scar, color, spot, etc. Bring a photo if you have one.
2. Come to the animal shelter every other day to see if your animal is here. Sometimes one person's idea of a medium black lab mix is another's large black German Shepherd.
3. Call radio station WTZQ at 828-692-1600 and file a free lost pet report. They are announced on air at 8:45am and 4:45pm.
4. The Times-News offers free lost pet ads. Call their number at 828-692-0505.
5. Create a poster with a photo of your animal on it. Post it at the shelter, around your neighborhood, and local businesses.
