Henderson County Holiday Closings

Hendersonville, NC – December 13, 2016

All Henderson County local government offices and agencies, the public library and its branches and the Henderson County Courthouse will be closed Friday, December 23rd through Monday, December 26th in observance of Christmas. County offices will reopen for normal business hours on Tuesday, December 27th. In addition, these offices will also be closed on Monday, January 2, 2017 in observance of New Year's.

The following agencies have amended holiday schedules:

- All branches of the Henderson County Public Library will close at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 22nd and remain closed until Tuesday, December 27th when they will reopen for their regular hours. All branches will again be closed on Monday, January 2, 2017 in observance of New Year's.
- The transfer station and the convenience center will be open on Friday, December 23rd. They will be closed on Saturday, December 24th and Monday, December 26th. In addition, the transfer station and convenience center will be closed on Monday, January 2, 2017, reopening on Tuesday, January 3, 2017 with regular business hours.
- The Henderson County Tourism Development Authority Visitor Center will be open on Friday, December 23rd from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. They will have shortened hours on Saturday, December 24th from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. On Christmas Day, Sunday, December 25th, the Visitor Center will be closed and will reopen on Monday, December 26th at 10:00 a.m. On Saturday, December 31st, the Visitor Center will be open from 10:00 a.m. till 3:00 p.m. and will be closed on Sunday, January 1st.

All Henderson County parks are open 365 days a year.

Delivery of emergency services will not be disrupted throughout the holidays.
